

### MyChart New Look New Features

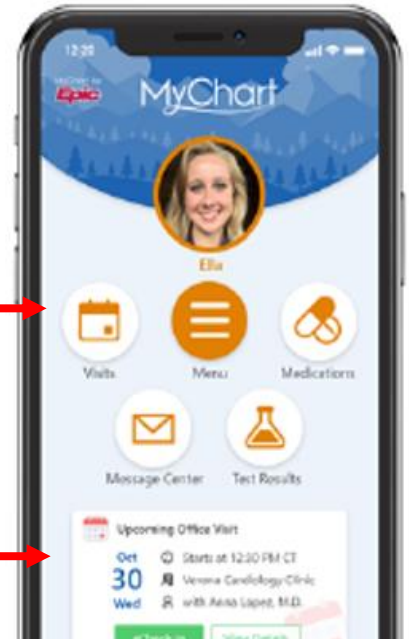
MyChart is getting updated on **October 21**. When we update MyChart, the mobile app and MyChart website works the same. Using MyChart on your phone or computer to manage your healthcare information will be even easier.

#### New Look:

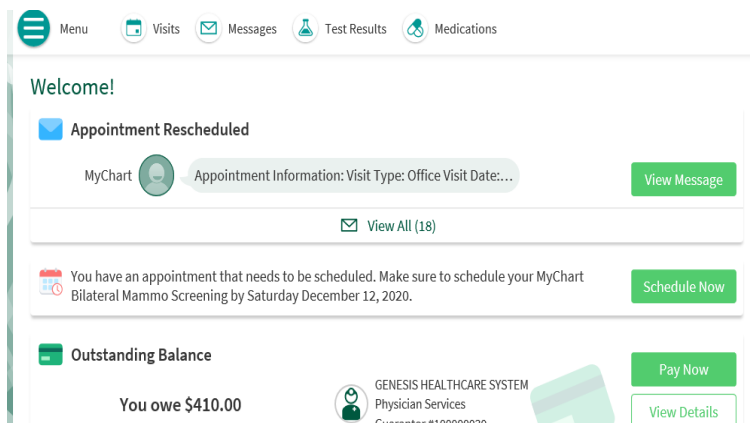
- MyChart's streamlined home page now includes short cut icons for common locations (Visits, medications, test results, messages) as well as a menu option for other locations.

#### New Features

- Below these icons is the health feed (just like a news feed). It includes alerts and reminders for you and the family members for whom you have healthcare proxy. Their information is color coded within the health feed. Everyone's information in one location.



From the health feed, click to complete items. Proceed to eCheck-in prior to your visits, add appointments to your calendar, even check your account balances. There is a "View Details" option for each health feed item. The menu icon includes items used less frequently. There is a search feature within the menu to quickly access these details.



This view is MyChart from your computer or tablet. Same icons across the top, Health feed in the center, care team on the right. Nearly every feature is found in both applications of Mychart.
